2.	Head Teacher's Report
	Mrs Kennedy took the meeting through a detailed end-of-year report. Firstly, there was an examination of this year's exam results. Key points raised were: Trend analysis is difficult due to the "COVID years" but overall, the results reflect positively on our young people.
	<ul> <li>4<sup>th</sup> year pupils (who were in the B.G.E. years during COVID restrictions) were most impacted, having missed out on Senior Phase school time during restrictions.</li> <li>The Literacy Curve overall, is shifting markedly to the left with 1<sup>st</sup> years, for the first time, being below the</li> </ul>
	National Average. Mrs Kennedy attributed this to, amongst other things, lack of reading books.
	An in-depth exam analysis followed with Mrs Kennedy fully explaining the details and implications of the results for 5 <sup>th</sup> and 6 <sup>th</sup> years, the most significant being that THS produced:
	Highest ever percentage pass rates for S5 pupils achieving 1+ Highers
	Highest ever percentage pass rates for S5 pupils achieving 3+Highers
	<ul> <li>Joint highest ever pass rates for S5 pupils achieving 5 Highers</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Joint highest ever pass rate for S6 pupils achieving 3+ Highers</li> <li>Joint highest ever pass rate for S6 pupils achieving 1+ Advanced Higher</li> </ul>

	Turnbull has the second highest presentation levels for NPA qualifications within EDC.
	Secondary schools are piloting "Sway" for E.D.C standards and quality reports. It provides a more interactive format that allows parents to view reports, presentations and videos.
3.	Report from the P.T.A. Chair
	Mrs Cowie discussed the PTA finances in depth.
	Events are to be resumed after COVID with the first being a family Quiz to be held in St. Dominic's Church hall on the 30 <sup>th</sup> September.
