2. Head Teacher's Report

The latest Standards and Quality Report is available for all those to read through at their own leisure, the link is available in the latest edition of the Turnbull Times. This report details the results in comparison to the rest of the country, the school's Vision, Values and Aims, the Improvement plan over the last session along with it's next steps, PEF Funding as well as Self Evaluation of the HMIE Report.

In regards to results, the following was noted –

S4 - 120 pupils,

S5 - 112 pupils

S6 – 82 this session.

Some negative attainment factors are increasing year on year, E.g mental health of our young people and the needs of the community are changing.

S4 – Nat 5 – Over the years decreasing in terms of percentage and pupils looking at other awards (SCQF) E.g Wellbeing and computer gaming.

S5 – obtaining 3+ highers along with SCQFs. The full data regarding SCQFs isn't available at present, will be at end September.

S6 – Advanced Highers results – need to ensure young pupils remain fully engaged in their learning
